- Heart valve surgery or replacement
- Surgery to improve circulation of heart, brain for extremities
- Chronic pulmonary disease (COPD)
- Emphysema
- Chronic bronchitis
- Respiratory failure
- Respiratory disease requiring oxygen
- Multiple sclerosis
- Grand mal seizures
- Parkinson's disease

- Amputation caused by disease
- Hospitalized more than twice
- Postponed or declined for life insurance

Within Last 3 Years

- Internal cancer
- Melanoma
- Leukemia
- Lymphoma
- Cirrhosis
- Liver failure
- Chronic pancreatitis
- Chronic hepatitis (Hepatitis B or C)
- Convicted of reckless driving or DUI

Within Last 5 Years

- Treatment for drug or alcohol abuse
- Suicide attempt
- Chronic pain requiring daily narcotic use
- Convicted of a felony

Within Last 10 Years, Had 2 or More:

- Insulin dependent diabetes
- Heart attack
- Heart value replacement
- Stroke
- Transient ischemic attack
- Carotid artery disease
- Peripheral vascular or artery disease

Ever

- AIDS, ARC or tested positive for HIV
- Chronic renal disease or failure

- Paralysis of 2 or more extremities
- Diagnosed with terminal illness
